## CENTRAL CIRCULAR AND PARTICIPATION IN IMA HQ EVENTS:

### MEETING WITH MPs (Feb 7, 2024):

Indian Medical Association orchestrated a remarkable gathering for Hon'ble Member's of Parliament at Hotel Le-Meridien, New Delhi. Over 60 MP's from across the nation graced the occasion with their presence, contributing their invaluable insights and perspectives. On this occasion National President Dr. R V Asokan and Honorary Secretary General Dr. Anilkumar J Nayak apprised the MPs about the concerns of the IMA. Amidst this enriching discourse, IMA proudly unveiled the "IMA Health Manifesto", a significant step towards advocating for comprehensive healthcare reforms. MPs from West Bengal have attended the meeting and promised to extend all kinds of support towards the fraternity.



**231ST MEETING OF CENTRAL WORKING COMMITTEE** of Indian Medical Association was held at MGM Beach Resorts, Chennai on April 13-14, 2024. Team IMA Bengal under the leadership of Dr. Santanu Sen (Past National President), Dr. Dilip Kumar Dutta (State President) etc. Team IMA Bengal attended the meeting. Leaders and office bearers from Bengal participated actively and took part in several discussions.



**STATE PRESIDENT AND SECRETARIES MEET (AUG 13, 2024):** A meeting of State Presidents and Secretaries was called on 13th August, 2024. On behalf of IMA Bengal, State President and Hony Secretary joined and explained whole scenario related to Abhaya incident in detail. In line of the decision and thought of fraternity, IMA HQ called withdrawal of service by all doctors of modern medicine across the country for 24 hours from 6AM on 17th Aug to 6AM on 18th Aug except Emergency services.

Another meeting of State Presidents and Secretaries was called on 20th August, 2024. IMA National President and national leaders showed solidarity towards the movement by junior doctors and fraternity to demand justice against this heinous crime. IMA HQ published several press releases. The disciplinary committee duly constituted by the National President Dr R V ASOKAN suo moto considered the rape and murder of a postgraduate resident and the subsequent developments in RG Kar Medical College Kolkata. The committee unanimously decided to suspend Dr Sandip Ghosh forthwith from the membership of Indian Medical Association.



## ABHAYA ISSUE

- Doctors as well as common people are still in a state of shock and anguish due to the heinous crime at RGKMCH. Junior Doctors along with several Associations are on road to earn the justice for Abhaya.
- Indian Medical Association Bengal State Branch under the aegis of IMA HQ stands in solidarity with the Junior Doctors and supports their demands wholeheartedly since very beginning.
- IMA Bengal formed an Action Committee and took some initiatives as a mode of protest.
- A 7 membered Action Committee was formed to look after the issue. IMA Action Committee has put tremendous efforts to unite all medicos and raise the voice for the Justice.
- A Black Badge Protest was organized throughout the state.
- A Mega Protest March was organized from RGK MCH to Dharmatala to show solidarity and demand for justice on 17.08.2024.
- In tune with the call by IMA HQ, IMA Bengal called 24 Hours withdrawal of services throughout the state on 17.08.2024.
- IMA Bengal announced free legal help to doctors and medical students who would be harassed by Police for nonviolent protest on Social Media.
- Press meets and Press releases have been organized along with other associations frequently to address the issue. A Press meet at press club was organized on 12.08.24.
- IMA Bengal organized a meeting with Principals of Medical Colleges of West Bengal and a Press Release was done thereafter.
- IMA Bengal organized Medical Teachers Convention where more than 150 fraternity of different ages and different categories joined and expressed their views on 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2024.
- IMA Bengal along with other associations has called a Sit and Demonstration on 11.09.2024 in front of West Bengal Medical Council.
- Local branches organized Protest Rallies in prominent places on 14th September, 2024 involving other professionals and common people.
- They met and submit demands of IMA to the District Magistrate and SP/ CP. Met and discussed with Principal of Medical Colleges of district regrading safety and security of Healthcare Professionals.

All healthcare professionals including Doctors, Nurses, Paramedical Staffs, Pharmacists, Medical Technologists and all professionals related to healthcare delivery system are invited to join.

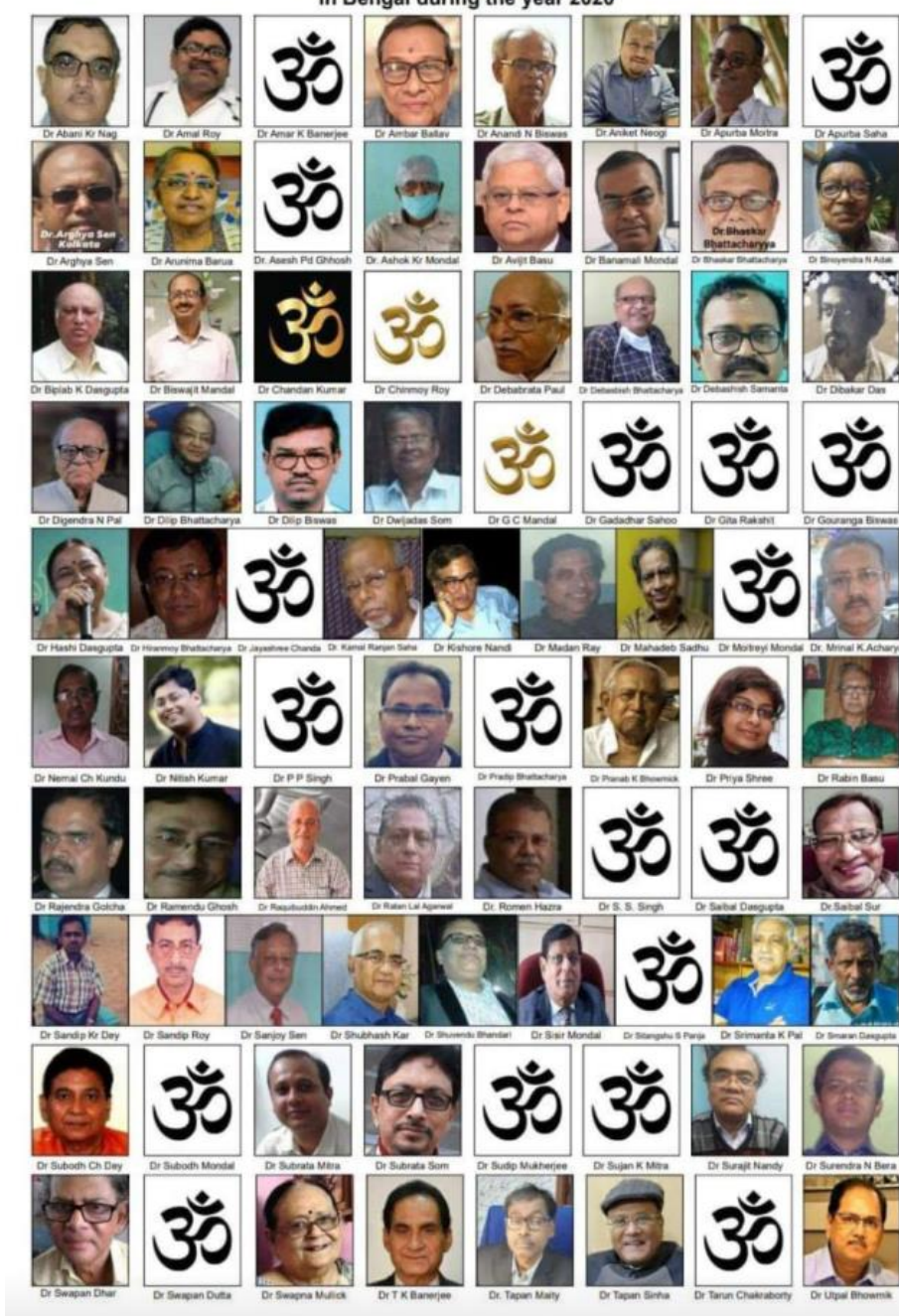
- Indian Medical Association Bengal State Branch called for protest and demonstration in front of CGO Complex to raise the voice and to earn the justice for Abhaya.

Congratulations to all who received award from National President in different categories.

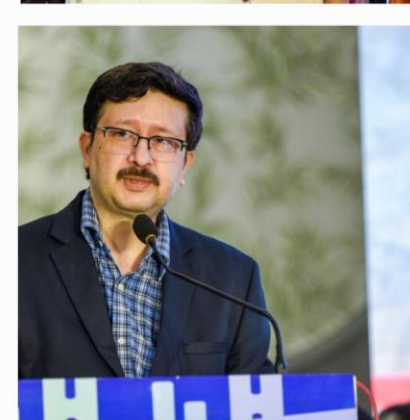


### EZ AMSCON 2024 (NOV 9, 2024)

The meeting lasted for more than 1 hour and IMA Bengal raised their concerns about the unlawful detainment and case against Dr Tapabrata Ray and also so that his career is not jeopardized because of this incident ! The meeting ended in a positive vibe with both sides expecting a fruitful outcome from the hearing of the case in Calcutta High Court.



- There were instances of violence on doctors in different areas of state. IMA Bengal along with local branches tried its best to reach out in all these cases without wasting time and took necessary steps. IMA state leaders under the leadership of State President and State Secretary visited and assured all kinds of help.
- We were able to operate the second elevator in Dr. B C Roy IMA House, Kolkata. With the active participation of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation(KMC).
